We would like to acknowledge PlaceMakers for their kind donation, their work and contributions to our kura.



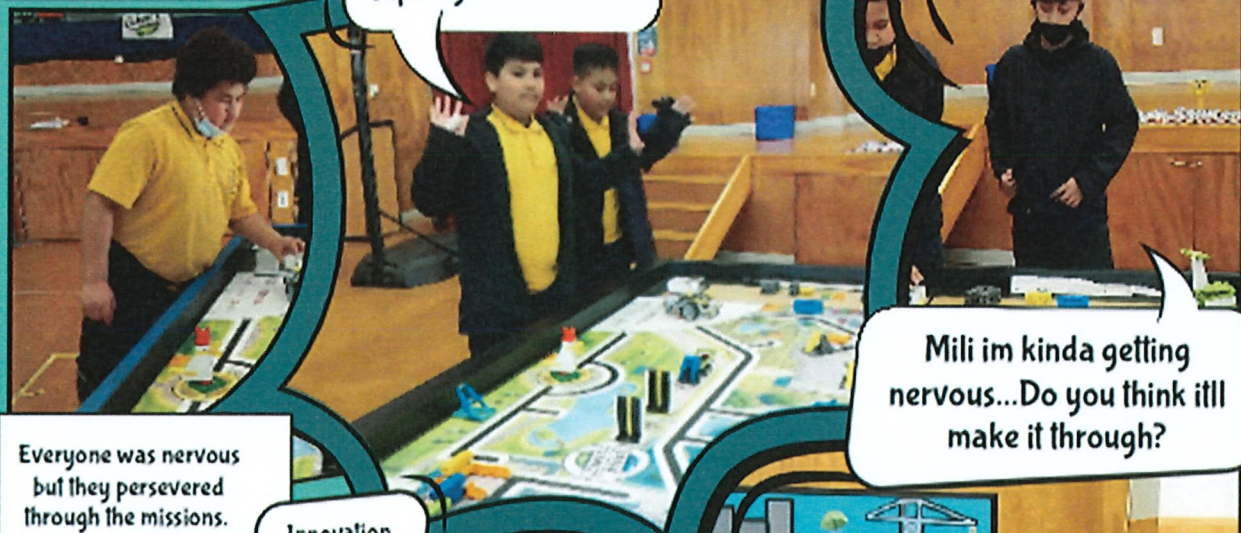

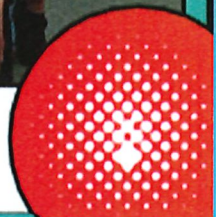

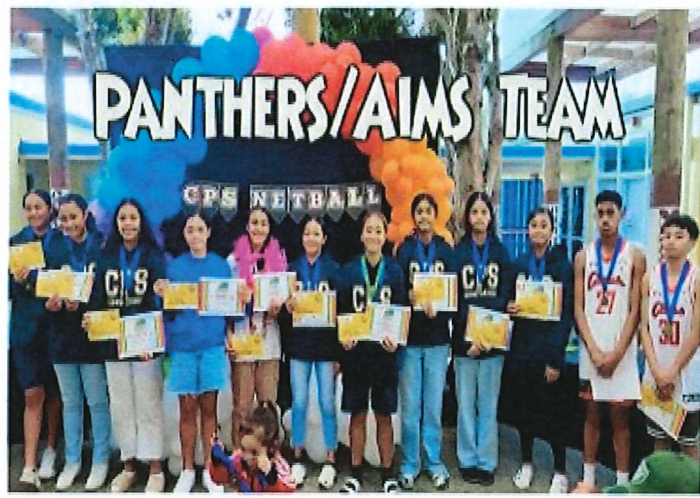
