Enrolments for High School

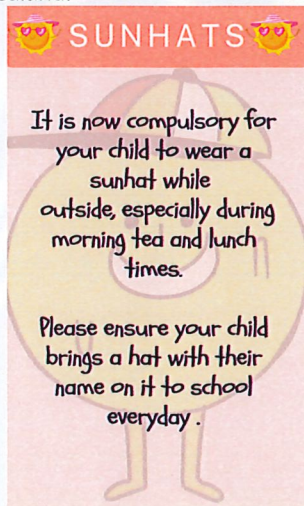

TAUTUA MO TUPIHAGA LEADERSHIP CAMP



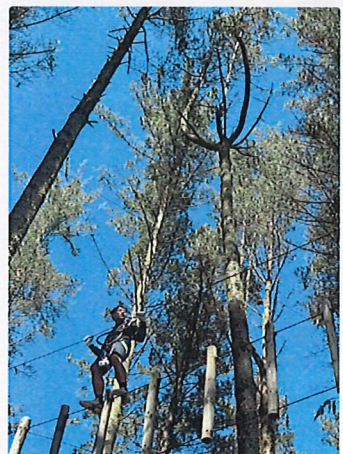

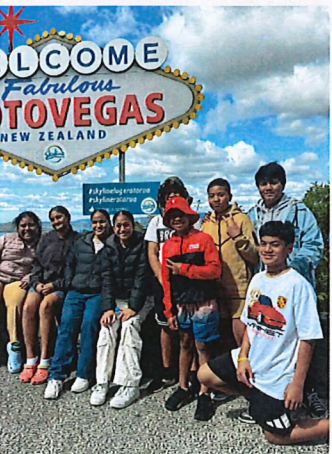
