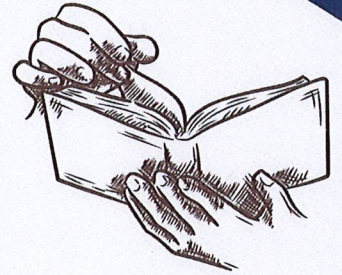

AIMS GAMES 2023:

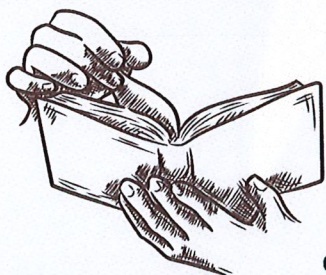
The AIMS Games is something I'll never forget,
