PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Talking to your children about online safety

Advice and tools to talk to your children about staying safe online.

The internet is a great place to connect with family and friends, learn, play games and watch videos and TV programmes. But it can also have downsides for our tamariki, rangatahi and young people. They may be exposed to pornography and other inappropriate content, bullied and 'groomed' by sexual predators without even realising it.

How to talk to your children about the internet

What do they already know?

Being a parent or caregiver in the digital age can be challenging and it can be hard to initiate a conversation about your child's online use. A good place to start is to figure out what they already know and what they use the internet and social media for.

How will you support them?

Our tamariki, rangatahi and young people can be worried about coming forward to talk to parents in case they get in trouble. Let them know you will support them no matter what.

Who to reach out to for help

The internet is a great place to connect with family and friends, but it can also expose tamariki and rangatahi and young people to online harms. Talk to your child about who they can reach out to if they need help.
